Pesticide Use Permit Application For Termiticide Treatment

For all structures to be treated for termites in the foundation or ground area surrounding or under the foundation, the applicator must submit a Pesticide Use Permit Application for Termiticide Treatment to the Director on a form provided for that purpose, accompanied by a non-refundable fee of fifty dollars. The request for a permit must be submitted to BECQ at least twenty business days prior to the proposed date of application. §65-70-305(a)(1)

Upon receipt of the Pesticide Use Permit Application for Termiticide Treatment, BECQ has up to ten (10) business days to process the permit. The permit is valid for 6 months after the date of issuance. §65-70-305(a)(2)

The applicator is required to notify BECQ in writing 48-hours prior to any termiticide application made under an approved permit. Unless pre-approved by BECQ, termiticide treatment shall <u>not</u> be phased or divided for a single structure. Termiticide applications conducted under an approved permit must be scheduled during BECQ's normal working hours. Further, the applicator must provide written notices of the date of application and the name and registration number used to each household and business that is located within <u>seventy-five</u> (75) feet of the proposed application. A copy of this written notice must be submitted to BECQ prior to the termiticide application. §65-70-305(b)

The applicator is required to provide BECQ with the following additional information:

1. Maps (a) Vicinity map showing the location of the proposed project site; (b) Vicinity map showing bodies of water within 100 feet of the proposed project site and (c) Driving directions to the project site

2. Building Foundation and footing plan, with measurements/dimensions of the project site

Please be advised that all of the information above in Section 3, 4, and 5 must be in conformance with the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency's health warning and instruction for use that is printed on the pesticide package. It is a violation of the CNMI and Federal Regulations to use pesticide in a manner that is inconsistent with its EPA approved labeling.

Section 6. REMINDERS

You are reminded that pursuant to NMIAC § 65-70-305, to prevent contamination of surface water, the following restrictions must be observed:

- (i) After the application, cover the treatment site in order to prevent runoff in the event of rain. <u>Note</u>: The applicator must either cover the soil him/herself or provide written notification of the above requirement to the contractor on site and to the person commissioning the application (if different than the contractor). If notice is provided to the contractor or the person commissioning the application, then they are responsible to ensure that: (A) If the concrete slab cannot be poured over the treated soil within 24 hours of application the treated soil is covered with a waterproof covering (such as polyethylene sheeting), and (B) the treated soil is covered if precipitation is predicted to occur before the concrete slab is scheduled to be poured;
- (ii) Do not treat soil that is water-saturated;
- (iii) Do not treat when raining;
- (iv) Do not allow treatment to runoff from the target area;
- (v) Do not apply within 10 feet of storm drains;
- (vi) Do not apply within 25 feet of bodies of water or aquatic habitats (such as, but not limited to, lakes, reservoirs, lagoon, permanent streams, marshes or ponds, estuaries, and commercial fish farm ponds);
- (vii) Do not make on-grade applications when sustained wind speeds are above 10 mph (at application site) at nozzle end height; and
- (viii) Follow any additional restrictions or requirements included in a permit issued by BECQ.
