### OPEN TO HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS!

- **ONE** entry per contestant.
- Must be your original artwork!
- All art work entries must be submitted on letter/ 8.5 x 11 inch paper
- Once the winning entries have been selected, the artist is **required** to paint their winning image at an assigned storm drain.

Students will receive Service Learning /Community Service hours. **The Bureau of Environmental Quality/EAM storm drain committee will provide paint and other materials available to contestants at no charge.**

### JUDGING

Entries will be judged on how effectively the art's message is in drawing public attention to one of the following:

- The fact that storm drains lead to the ocean and dumping in them is an act of pollution.
- Reflect this year's EAM 2026 theme: ***"Land and Life in Harmony"***

Creativity, and uniqueness of the artwork will also be considered. *\*Selected art pieces will be enlarged to fit on a sidewalk (up to a 4 x 6 foot space)*

### MONETARY PRIZES

Will be awarded for 1<sup>st</sup> Place (\$200), 2<sup>nd</sup> Place (\$150), 3<sup>rd</sup> Place (\$100). Six (6) others will win **"Honorable mention"** and \$50 each. All **nine (9)** winners will transfer their artwork to storm drainages located in Garapan.
